## BEHOLD THE PATTERN!

### Introduction:

- A. Text (Phil. 2:1-10)
- B. (1 Pet. 2:21; Rom. 6:17)
- C. Let's note four known concepts for every Christian knows to *Behold the Pattern!*

### I. THE PATTERN FOR \_\_\_\_\_.

- A. (Phil. 2:5-6) 5. "Let **this mind** be in you which was also in Christ Jesus, 6. who, being in the form of God, did not **consider** it robbery to be equal with God,"
- B. (Phil. 2:3; 1 Cor. 2:16)

### II. THE PATTERN FOR \_\_\_\_\_.

- A. (Phil. 2:6-7) 6. "who, **being in the form of God**, did not consider it robbery to be equal with God, 7. but made Himself of no reputation, taking the form of a bondservant, and coming in the likeness of men."
- B. (John 1:1; John 1:3; John 1:14; 1 Cor. 4:10)

### III. THE PATTERN FOR \_\_\_\_\_.

- A. (Phil. 2:7-8) 7. "but made Himself of no reputation, **taking the form of a bondservant**, and coming in the likeness of men. 8. And being found in appearance as a man, **He humbled Himself and became obedient** to the point of death, even the death of the cross."
- B. (Mark 10:45; Heb. 5:8; Luke 22:42; John 13:13-17)

### IV. THE PATTERN FOR \_\_\_\_\_.

- A. (Phil. 2:8-9) 8. "And being found in appearance as a man, He humbled Himself and became obedient to the point of death, even the death of the cross. 9. **Therefore God also has highly exalted Him** and given Him the name which is above every name,"
- B. (John 19:26; Luke 23:34; Luke 23:43; Luke 23:46; Mat. 27:46; Phil. 1:21)
